



SUMMARY OF HIGHLIGHTS AT ST JOHN'S NARRAWEENA

MISSION

- Welcome Liturgy for all, especially our new students, staff and families.
- Special celebrations Ash Wednesday; Holy Week Liturgies; Feast of the Ascension and Assumption; Focus on our Mother Mary in May and October and our Prayer garden – Feast of Mary of the Cross – First Australian Saint.
- Mission Project Day working with other schools to share mission projects.
- Student led social justice initiatives to support Caritas Project Compassion, Saint Vincent De Paul; Catholic Mission Australia; and Bear Cottage including the annual Talent Quest fundraiser; promote sustainability through compost & recycling in the school.
- Community outreach pre-school visit program; Palm Grove nursing home visits.
- Weekly Prayer Assembly Each grade rostered to lead the whole school Prayer assembly.
- Each class to attend weekly mass during the term.
- Monthly 'Mass with the Parish' on Saturday afternoons at 5pm. Grades to assist with reading, singing and hospitality on a rostered basis.
- Core Values Awards presented at the end of each term, linked to our 6 school values of Hope, Compassion, Justice, Respect, Celebration & Service.

TEACHING AND LEARNING

- Individual Maths Assessment Interviews (MAI) for each student to determine learning levels and progress – this approach supported by research.
- Whole school standardised assessments annually to track student progress (Maths & English).
- Regular Reading and Writing assessment to monitor progress towards benchmarks, particularly in the early years.

- Linking learning between home and school using technology.
- Lunchtime Coding and Construction clubs.
- Challenge based learning and Project based learning particularly in years 5 & 6.
- Learning Support Specialist Teacher.
- Senior camp program.
- Speech Pathology and Occupational Therapy optional services available at school.
- ESL Teacher support for children with English as their second/additional language.
- Parent Education Sessions Ages and Stages;
 Transition to School; Transition to High School,
