Dear Parents,

Welcome back to school for Term Two.

Our Year 1 children led a beautiful liturgy yesterday to help us celebrate the resurrection of Jesus. Their liturgy was the culmination of a whole school effort, led by the children, to experience the great love of Jesus during his passion, death and resurrection. Each grade poignantly presented their piece of the Holy Week and Easter story. Anyone attending our liturgies would have witnessed the depth of difference our children experience in attending St John's. Our teachers did an amazing job engaging and preparing our children for these key celebrations of our faith story.


A reminder that the uniform requirement is for predominantly white sport shoes for our sports uniform.

### School Uniform Shop Reminder




