PRINCIPAL'S MESSGAGE

Dear Parents.

Everyone is still on a high today after last night's musical production. The children lifted to another level on stage last night and we are all so proud of them. I am very much looking forward to the production of the DVD of the event and we will have information about order forms to you as soon as possible.

'Imagine a Musical' has been a wonderful community event and I offer my thanks again to all parents, staff and children involved in the production - from set, costume and prop making through to the preparation and ticket sales. We had approximately 1400 people (including the children) in attendance last night. This was true testament to the support that is within our community.

I believe the children have had a wonderful opportunity to experience performance and to understand what is involved in putting a production together. In particular, they have had direct experience in seeing how people have to work together to create something special.

We have decided to have a low key day at school today after

all the excitement of last night. There were no awards assemblies today. We will be holding our first Core Values Awards Assembly on Monday morning at 8:45 in the school hall. Information about this event is presented further on in the newsletter.

Finally, we finish school next Friday September 23rd for Term Three. Next week begins the phase in period for Summer uniform.
