Book Week Parade





Fr Vogt Writing Competition







Hooray Playgroup is back! Here's a message from Zuzana B (mum of Tommy in Yr 1) - our wonderful new leader....

I am very excited to invite local pre-schoolers and their parents and carers to St John's playgroup. It is aimed at children 3 - 5 years of age but younger siblings are welcome. This is a beautiful opportunity for children to get to know St John's, make new friends, play, learn and have fun.

We read, sing and do craft in every session. There is always plenty of time for free play as well, giving parents a chance to connect and relax.

This term the topic is "Making things." In week one, we used coloured rice for playing and learning about volumes. We explored different materials and the sounds they make and in the end, the children made simple musical shakers for the playgroup. In the coming sessions, the children will have a chance to bake bread, create their own building blocks and make things from recycled household materials.

At the moment, the playgroup runs fortnightly on Tuesday mornings, in term 3 it will be weeks 1, 3, 5, 7 and 9. It's free and open to anyone, please just bring morning tea for your child.
