What has emerged from our reflections is deep sadness but great appreciation for the many qualities and gifts Mrs Kauffmann has shared with us - her generous spirit; positivity; deep love for the children, her family and many friends and especially her courage and wisdom. These are just of the few things that have emerged consistently from our community about the impact she has had upon us.

Today will be an extremely sad day but a celebration of a wonderful young life that has inspired us all.

We have been asked by some of you how you can help. We also ask for your prayers and thoughts for our friends at St Lucy's on the first anniversary of the tragic passing of the Manrique family.



## WHAT TO DO IF YOUR CHILD IS ABSENT FROM SCHOOL FOR A DAY

If your child is sick or absent from school, you are legally obliged to need to contact the school and provide a reason for your child's absence. To explain an absence parents and carers may send a note or an email or Flexibuzz message to the school (with an explanation); telephone the school or visit the school. Absence notes are available on our <u>school website</u>. Taking children out of school for long absences is discouraged. If children are away from school for 10 days or longer, an **'Application for Extended Leave'** (available on the <u>school website</u>) must be completed and signed off by the school principal. The principal will determine whether any absence is justified or unjustified and whether a pattern of absences needs to be followed up. Expectations on schools for the monitoring of school attendance have been increased. We appreciate your cooperation in helping us with this obligation.

A reminder – if you have kept your child home from school today due to Mrs Kauffman's funeral – please ensure you still send a Flexibuzz, email or note to school for our class rolls – a legal document.

Please return the permission notes to the office as soon as possible.


#### LIBRARY NEWS
