Dear Parents,

Children are capable of remarkable things.

During 2017, I have seen children so moved by compassion that they are driven to respond in impressive and contagious ways. Support for research into a cure for cancer have been very well supported. Organisations like Tour for Cure, Walk4braincancer, Bear Cottage and the Children's Hospital have all attracted individual and group efforts of support from our wonderful children. Beyond this there have been neighbourhood drives including cake and lemonade stalls, colouring, guessing and handball competitions sparked by a need to bring hope and respond to a cause that touches the heart.

I have had to hold some activities back because of the sheer volume of causes that the children have wished to support – a tough decision when the spirit is so willing!

Children spend 7 years of their lives at primary school. These are important, formative years. When values like those mentioned above are expressed and acted upon, they become embedded in the person. I often hear that it is high school where 'the rubber hits the road' in terms of education, but the more I see how our school connects our core values to real life, the more it reveals how the impact of our work, in partnership with parents, impacts our children in a holistic way. Doing that work in an atmosphere of faith adds further depth and meaning.

The above was emphasised for us last night at our Year 6 Graduation. Our children led a truly beautiful liturgy which highlighted what it is to be a Year 6 student at St John's. It was very special to be a part of something that displayed not only their journey since 2011 but the way in which they have been encouraged and support along the way. Special thanks to our Year One buddy parents for providing a delicious supper for the 200 strong in attendance and to members of our School Advisory Council for the setup, service and a clean-up last night.



On Saturday evening we will be celebrating our final Mass with the Parish for 2017. Thank you to all families who have responded to our invitation and informed us of requirements for the BBQ. I encourage a strong attendance for this celebration as we head into the final week of school. A reminder that our End of Year Liturgy will be held Friday, December 15th in the Church beginning at 11:15 am. This is a time for us to gather to look back on the year; to do some acknowledgements and to present special awards and announce our student leaders for 2018. All parents are welcome to attend.

Following the liturgy, parents are permitted to take their children home once teachers have been informed. Supervision will be in place until the end of the school day for any children remaining at school.
