PRINCIPAL NEWS

Dear Parents,

While hat parades, the Easter Bunny and chocolates all bring great fun and excitement is important to focus on the essence of the season and why it is so important to us as a faith community.

Our children have been sharing the story of Holy Week at school as we move toward the great celebration of Easter. On Monday morning, Kindergarten presented the triumphant entrance of Jesus into Jerusalem complete with donkey, waving palms and high enthusiasm (extremely cute). We were so proud of the way in which our youngest grade told the story so beautifully and in a way that set the scene for the rest of this week for us.

Yesterday afternoon, Year 4 drew us in to the story of Jesus washing the feet of the disciples to encourage us to love one another, despite the difficulties and challenges we face in doing so. We were then transported by Year 3 to the Last Supper where Jesus gave us the great gift of the Eucharist – 'do this in memory of me'. Year 2 poignantly and dramatically then took us to the garden of Gethsemane where Jesus prayed, was betrayed and then arrested. Tomorrow afternoon Years 5 and 6 lead us through the events of the Passion and give us an insight into his great suffering and love for us. It is inspiring and moving to see our children so involved and reflective about this important time in our year as a Catholic community. Parents are welcome to attend our final liturgy at 2:15 p.m. on Friday afternoon. Holy Week begins this Palm Sunday in our local parishes.

This is the final week of school for Term 1. We return to school Tuesday, April 30th to begin Term 2. Thank you for your involvement with us during the term. I wish to acknowledge the amazing work of our staff at St John's. It has been an extremely busy term for them and they have done their very best to provide the best Catholic education they can for your child.

NAPLAN

Our children will be taking part in NAPLAN online this year during Week 3 of Term 2, as will all schools in the Diocese of Broken Bay. Our Year 3 and 5 children have participated in the practice sessions using iPads with trial sessions running smoothly. The diocese provided keyboards for each iPad we are using for NAPLAN. Year 3 will use handwriting to complete the Writing Test with Year 5 moving to the use of a keyboard. All other tests will be completed online. In other NAPLAN news, we were very pleased to receive confirmation from ACARA that we achieved substantially above average gain in last year's NAPLAN results.
