Dear Parents,

You are invited to come to Mass this Saturday evening at 5:00 pm. This is our final Saturday Mass for the year and the focus will be on Advent – preparing for the birth of Jesus. There will be carols at the entrance of the Church from 4.40pm.



Our Kindergarten class celebrated the beginning of the Advent season with us on Monday morning by lighting the first candle on the Advent wreath – the candle of hope. Their prayer helped focus our thoughts on preparing our hearts for Jesus. This weekend we light the second candle, the candle of peace that reminds us of Mary's acceptance of God's will and the journey of Mary and Joseph to Bethlehem. We have lots of 'Yes' RSVP's for this Saturday afternoon's mass at 5 pm (with Carols at 4:40). Families from K-6 are invited to attend the celebration followed by a sausage sizzle.






Compass Quick Guides - Parents Accessing Reports


In order to access your children's Semester reports, you will need to:
