

<u>Cheat Sheet</u> for Starting School in Kindergarten 2021

<u>Title</u>	<u>Details</u>
Transition Sessions	We expect at least I parent or carer to attend each of the 3 sessions with their child. They take place in Room I and 2, with a class teacher and other staff members. It is an opportunity for your child to play and experience the classroom, the teacher and the staff with you by their side. We encourage parents to play with their children and be part of the learning experience. Session 3: All orders for school bags and hats will be handed out at these sessions. The second hand uniform shop will be open from 10:40-11am at the end of this session.
Playgroup	Playgroup sessions are optional. They take place in the OOSH (Out of School Hours room) in the school hall. They offer an opportunity to familiarise your child with the school and meet other local families, in a stimulating learning environment with varied play opportunities. Parish Mass Blessing of the Kinder 2021	A special community mass to welcome families to the community. Kinder 2021 children are invited to the front of the church to receive a blessing from the Priest and the community.
Best Start Assessments	Individual assessments take place before the Kindergarten children start school. An assessment takes approx. 45 minutes. You will receive information about how to make a booking via the school booking system closer to the time. You will be asked to drop your child off at the Kindergarten classroom and let them proceed to the assessment with the teacher. Children are assessed on their numeracy and literacy skills to help the teacher gauge where each child's starting point is. It is not necessary to prep your child for this assessment.

	Our goal is to prepare ourselves for your child, wherever they are in their learning journey, rather than you having to prepare your child for a certain starting point with us.
Mass followed by Kinder Picnic in back playground	All families are invited to join the usual Sunday Mass from 10-11am. After Mass, from 11-1pm we will gather in the back playground for a picnic. Please BYO everything. It is a great opportunity for children and families to mingle and re-familiarize themselves with the school and staff, as there has been a 2 month break since the last Transition Session over the Christmas break.
First Full Day of School for Kinder 2021	The first day of school will be a FULL day of school for Kindies. For dates please refer to the Transition to School process.

Compass Parent Portal	Compass is an app which parents use to receive instant messages, newsletters, notices and calendar events and to register absences. Qkr (by MasterCard)	QKR is as an easy to use, secure phone app for making school payments from your mobile phone. Qkr will accept payment using ANY credit/debit card (except American Express) and has a simple checkout function. No info is stored on the mobile phone. We are

Our school uniform shop which supplies bags and hats is run by a volunteer, so please help her by placing your order on time, so that she has plenty of time to buy supplies and deliver to you.

	New Hats, Bags and Second Hand Uniforms: The uniform shop, located next to the canteen at school sells school hats, bags and a small amount of second hand uniforms on Fridays from 8.30am-9am or 2:30pm-3pm. Please label all your child's belongings before they bring them to school. We will also open the Uniform Shop at the end of the 3rd Transition to School sessions on Tuesday 24 th and Thursday 26 th November from 10:40-11am for second hand uniforms.
	Shoes: Children are to wear black leather school shoes (Clark type) and predominantly white sport shoes on sports and physical education day.
