PRINCIPAL NEWS

Dear Parents,

We are in the process of revising the school newsletter. Our experience during the pandemic has shown that the succinctness of Compass communications has been appreciated. The fact that notifications are sent directly to your phones and/or an email has meant that access to messages is easy and they are focused via the one application. The downside has been that Compass messages expire and therefore there has been no archive of newsletter information for parents or prospective parents to reference via our website. In addition to the above, we have appreciated the time we have been able to redirect to other priorities whilst not producing a weekly newsletter.

So, you will receive standard newsletter until we have a new plan in place.

Firstly, my thanks to you for the cooperation being shown with the restrictions in place concerning drop off, pick up and attending to children with cold and flu like symptoms. We very much appreciate updated reports from parents whose children have been away from school for a continued period. Our recommendation is that parents be advised by their GP if anyone in the family is experiencing these symptoms. These safety of everyone in the community depends on sustaining a responsible attitude towards managing illness and taking part in COVID testing.

I am pleased that the children will be able to receive their First Reconciliation next week. We are working with Father Reinaldo on how to run preparation for the sacraments in a COVID environment.

In other news, we will restart Merit Assemblies on Friday mornings in the St John's Hall. We are looking forward to finally being able to use the hall after the significant renovations that have taken place in recent months.

In addition, we are also planning to go ahead with our annual Athletics Carnival July 30th at Beverley Job Oval. Unfortunately, we are not able to have parents attend these events due to the restrictions in place.

We will continue to post information on Facebook about these and other school events to help keep you connected in some way with happenings at St John's.

We are not quite back to normal yet, but we will have a video to share with you on Monday Week 10.





