Dear Parents,

This is the final day of Term 2 for the children. The staff will be spending tomorrow working with Bishop Anthony and our Interim Director, Danny Casey. Our new leaders will be sharing their vision to 2025 and will discuss key actions for Catholic Schools during that time.

I'd like to take this opportunity to thank you for your wonderful support and your patient cooperation during what has been one of the most challenging terms I've experienced. We've adapted to and managed incredibly rapid change. The St John's staff have been true superstars in the way they have cared for your children. I hope they thoroughly enjoy a well-deserved break.

Looking at Melbourne's experience this week, caution and diligence is required by each of us if we are to continue moving successfully back to normal teaching, learning and community life. Please keep up your guard and follow the hygiene and social distancing guidelines in place in our state.

Congratulations to all St John's children who received the Sacrament of Reconciliation this week. The children's preparation was interrupted by the pandemic but it was a special time for them as they celebrated with their teachers and classmates this week. Our thanks to Father Rei and Father Emman who led the children through the receipt of the sacrament. Confirmation and First Eucharist are due to be celebrated in Term 3, details of how the preparation for these Sacraments will be carried out will be communicated by the Parish and as soon as we have details we'll let you know.

Term 3 begins Monday, July 20th. This was originally planned as a Pupil Free Day but will now be a normal school day. All Pupil Free Days for the remainder of the year, apart from July 3rd, have been cancelled given the time taken by schools to prepare for Home Based Learning at the end of Term 1 and beginning of Term 2. St John's staff will take part in two out of hours, 4-6:30 pm sessions during Term 3, to minimise disruption to the community but to also take part in professional learning which will be worthwhile for your child.

On your return to Term 3, you are advised that drop off and pick up arrangements will continue as they are. K-2 pick-up at 2:55 pm will continue; children catching the Alfred Street buses will leave at 3:00 pm and all other children will leave at 3:05 pm. From the beginning of Term Three, Miss Dunk will not be at Waratah Parade drop off each morning which means children will need to walk into school on their own. Parents are only permitted on site for individual meetings after registering at the front desk. While we will begin with our Prayer Assemblies and Merit Assemblies next term, unfortunately parents cannot attend these events until further notice. We'll continue to use Facebook and Compass to keep you in the loop.

SCHOOL PHOTOS - MONDAY 10 AUGUST 2020

Put the date in your calendar and make sure your children arrive at school on time and looking their best for our school photos on Monday 10th August (Week 4, Term 3). Attached to this newsletter is information on ordering online via Compass.

MSP Photography will follow the most up to date COVID-19 safety measures for our school photo day. The latest information we have available is that our photos this year will be a 'composite style' with students photographed individually, and then groups created digitally as a composite.

ADDITIONAL PROTOCOLS INCLUDE:

- Students will move in and out of the portrait studio area individually.
- The area will be set up in such a way as to ensure that each individual student will maintain the recommended social distancing guidelines of 1.5m from other students and the photographer.
- MSP Photography staff will provide instructions to each class upon entry to the photography area. Hygiene and cleaning guidelines used by MSP Photography staff are in accordance with information distributed by the relevant Health Authorities.

As per all recommendations, if a child is unwell there is no need for them to attend photo day. MSP Photography will provide a catch-up session for students who may be absent on photo day.

We will keep you updated next term on any further information we receive.

As we finish the term (and get ready for school photos next term!), we've noticed a few variations in the uniform combinations being worn (missing ties, wrong coloured shoes or socks, etc). If you need to make any purchases to prepare for Term 3, the Clothing Pool is currently operating via Qkr.



Please ensure your child comes to school every day wearing a jumper in the morning. There are a concerning number of children without jumpers on in these winter months. Children also must wear their <u>school hat</u> every day. Hats should really 'live' in school bags (when they are not on children's heads!). And of course, please ensure your child's name is <u>clearly labelled</u> on all of their belongings. When purchasing items from the clothing pool, please remember to change the name from the previous owner. Your help with this is appreciated.

UNSW ICAS COMPETITION INFORMATION - CLOSING DATE FRIDAY 17TH JULY

St John's provides supervision for students wishing to take the ICAS Assessments. The assessments are designed for high potential students to be extended and challenged in a competition environment. The assessments are optional and are charged at a per assessment rate.

In 2020 students have the opportunity to participate in the following subjects: Science (Yr 2-6) – sitting date – Tuesday 18th August (Week 5, Term 3) Digital Technology (Yr 3-6) – sitting date – Tuesday 25th August (Week 6, Term 3) English (Yr 2-6) – sitting date – Thursday 27th August (Week 6, Term 3) Maths (Yr 2-6) – sitting date – Tuesday 1st September (Week 7, Term 3) Spelling Bee (Yr 2-6) – sitting date – Thursday 3rd September (Week 7, Term 3) Please note – Writing is not available in 2020. Cost per test: \$15.95 including GST Parents can login to the Parent Portal to purchase tests for their child/ren.

The assessments will take place before school at 8.00am in the library. Children should arrive by **7.50am** to get themselves organised and logged in to begin the test at 8am. The school will provide the devices, but children should bring headphones for all tests (just in case. It is definitely needed for Spelling). We cannot guarantee that we will be able to make up test times if your child is late or absent.
