### Season of Creation

What is the Season of Creation you might be asking?



The Season of Creation is a monthlong prayerful observance that calls the planet's 2.2 billion Christians to pray and care for God's creation. It's a time to reflect on our relationship with the environment — not just "distant" nature, but, crucially, the place where we live — and the ways in which our lifestyles and decisions as a society can endanger both the natural world and those inhabiting it, both humans and other creatures. It's a time of prayer, contemplation and, increasingly, calls to action.

This is a snippet of a letter which Pope Francis wrote for the Season of Creation:

I am very pleased that the theme chosen by the ecumenical family for the celebration of the 2020 Season of Creation is Jubilee for the Earth, precisely in this year that marks the fiftieth anniversary of Earth Day. In the Holy Scriptures, a Jubilee is a sacred time to remember, return, rest, restore, and rejoice.

We are fortunate to live in an age when our children are far better informed about the state of the planet than any previous generation. With the support of family, school, community... there is no limit to what they can achieve.




